Adult Co-Ed Recreation Softball Code of Conduct

Team Manager, sign & return

The primary purpose of adult sports programs is to offer our community the opportunity to pursue, through competitive sports, the physical and emotional benefits such activities offer.

All too often the emphasis in such participation has been placed on winning at any cost.

It should be remembered that in every competitive sports activity there are winners and losers. The purpose of this Code of Conduct, applicable to every participant, is to engender and motivate a return to good sportsmanship, proper conduct on and off the field, and fully complying with the rule and policies of the City of Ammon Parks & Recreation Department.

Effective immediately, the Code of Conduct, as defined below, is in force. Team managers will carefully review the rule and requirements herewith set forth and make them known to their players. They are solely responsible for the actions of their teams and players, on and off the field. Improper behavior on the part of any participant can directly affect the future participation by the entire team. No alcoholic beverages and/or smoking are allowed in or on recreation centers by players, managers, and/or spectators. Penalty: Immediate suspension and loss of league fees.

The Participation's Code of Conduct applies to all players, coaches, and managers. This code applies to players as individuals and/or as a team, and the penalties can be applied to an individual and/or an entire team. This code becomes effective as soon as the participants arrive at the facility of play and remains in effect until the participants leave the facility.

- A. No Participant shall:
 - a. At any time lay hand(s) upon, push, shove, strike, or threaten to strike an official.
 - b. Be guilty of physical attack as an aggressor upon any player, official, or spectator.
 - c. Endanger the safety of any player, official, or spectator.
- B. No Participant shall:
 - a. Refuse to abide by an official's decision.
 - b. Be guilty of personal or verbal abuse upon any official for any real or imaginary wrong decision or judgement.
 - c. Be guilty of using unnecessarily rough tactics in the play of the game against an opposing player.
- C. No Participant shall:
 - a. Be guilty of objectionable demonstrations of dissent at an official's decision by throwing equipment or any forceful action.
 - b. Discuss with any official in any manner the decision reached by such official (except Manager).
- D. No Participant shall:
 - a. Smoke while going to or leaving the facility, or while on the field of play.
 - b. Be guilty of discussing publicly with spectators in a derogatory manner any play, decision, or personal opinion of other players during the game (NO trash talk).
 - c. Appear on/at the facility at any time in an intoxicated condition, or consume any alcoholic beverage while at the recreational facility.
- E. All players must sign Registration waiver prior to participation.

We understand and agree to abide by all the rules, regulations, and Code of Conduct which includes any disciplinary measures or suspensions levied.

MY SIGNATURE ACKNOWLEDGES THAT I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND EACH AND EVERY ONE OF THE ABOVE PROVISIONS. VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION SHALL RESULT IN MY EXPULSION AND AGREEMENT THAT I SHALL NOT PARTICIPATE FOR NOT LESS THAN TWO YEARS.

Ammon Adult Co-Ed Recreation Softball League Rules

This league is a registered ASA league. ASA rules will be in effect except for the following league rules:

1. Ten players (five [5] men and five [5] women) are on the field at one time, alternating in the batting order. The extra player rule can be used (12 bat, any 10 can play).
2. A team can begin the game with eight (8) players. Designated outs will be used in place of the missing players.
3. Three (3) home runs allowed per team per game. After three home runs have been scored, an out will be called on any additional home runs. This does not include inside the park home runs and assisted home runs.
4. One (1) hour time limit. No new inning will begin after one hour. A game is 7 innings or 1 hour, whichever comes first. If one hour arrives before 7 innings, the game is over no matter how many innings are played.
5. If a female is pitching, a male must catch. If a male is pitching, a female must catch.
6. Outfield must have 4 players (2 males, 2 females, any order).
7. Sliding is allowed but must be done legally. No intentional contact with players is allowed at any time. Intentional contact could result in ejections from the game and/or league.
8. Any walk to a male batter will result in a two base award. The next batter, a female, will bat. EXCEPTION: with two outs, the female batter has the option to walk or bat. See ASA rule book.
9. Matching uniforms are not required.
10. Games must begin on time. Teams need to provide line-ups to the other team 5-10 minutes before the game begins.
11. Teams are responsible for their own scorekeeping.
12. If problems arise on the score, the official will be the final arbitrator.
13. Outfield arc will be used. Outfielders must play behind arc (150 feet).
14. Ten (10) runs in one inning will be used for four (4) innings only by continuation or runners or outs, it is possible to score thirteen (13) runs. After the 5th inning the rule is not in effect. Three (3) outs must be made.
15. Run rules will be used. Twenty (20) run rule after four (4) innings and fifteen (15) run rule after five (5) innings.
16. No steel cleats or steel spiked shoes are allowed.
17. Minimum age to play is sixteen (16) years old.
18. When starting the game with less than ten (10) players, females may fill in for male players (example: 6 women, 4 men). When playing less than four (4) outfielders, a maximum of two (2) males are allowed in the outfield. Teams can begin a game with five (5) males and three (3) females. Never are more than five (5) males allowed on the field at any time.
19. Teams must play with players designated on their rosters. Game substitutions should register with the umpire before entering the game. No free substitutions.
20. Your team fee includes receiving softballs for the games. Home team should supply new ball and visiting team should supply good used ball for the games.
